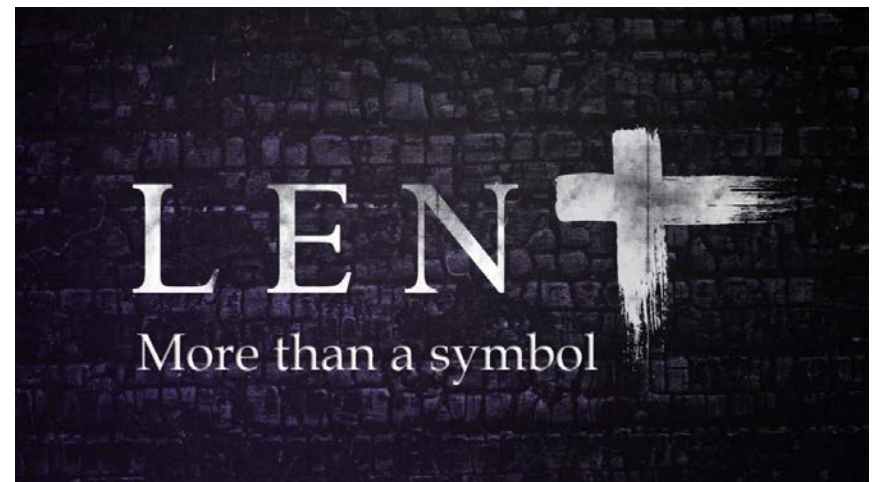
5. WEDNESDAY, MARCH 20TH – Youth Groups for students in Kindergarten through 12th grade meet at 6:45 P.M.
