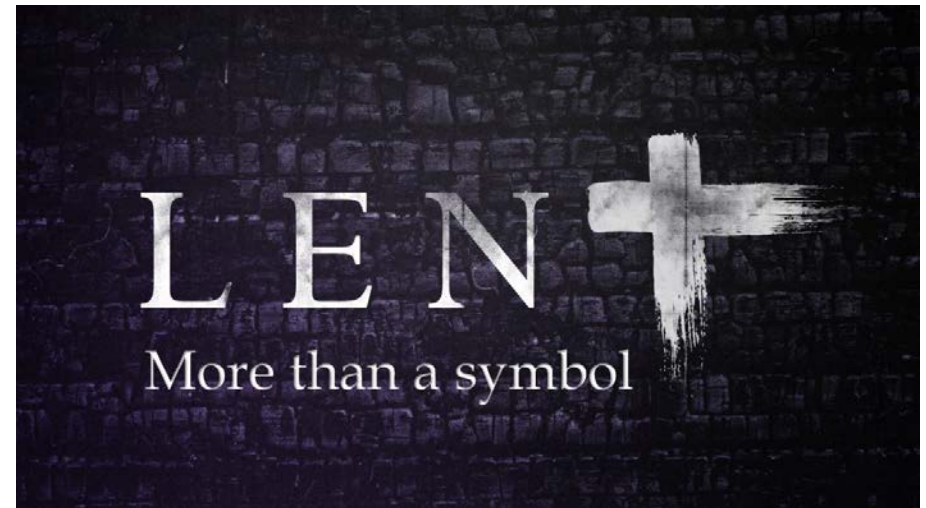


ANNOUNCEMENTS
